Diploma courses. However, candidates who have obtained Bachelor's degree through Open Universities without going through 10+2+3 pattern will not be

eligible. Candidates should have studied Tamil as a subject in X/XII/Degree. If not studied, candidates will have to pass the Tamil Part-II Test conducted by Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission within 2 years of joining the service.
